THEME

We are looking for original drawings or paintings that depict anything related to this topic: food, art, festivities, paintings and traditions from Native Americans, Spaniards, Mexican, Americans and every other community that made New Mexico a great State.

INFORMATION

Teachers are encouraged to introduce this topic in the classroom. The drawings and paintings will be displayed at the Education Building at the National Hispanic Cultural Center from January 18th through March 6th, 2020.

Each artwork must have (on the back of the drawing) the following information:

- Contestant's first and last name
- Age
- Name of school
- Teacher's phone number & email

Format: Original artworks 17 x 11 inches (horizontal or vertical). All drawings must be sent by **December 16th** to:

PARTICIPANT AND AGE CATEGORY

We encourage all school districts from New Mexico to participate. There are three age categories:

- 6 to 8 years old (Sponsored by The Kurz Foundation)
- 9 to 12 years old (Sponsored by Century Automotive, a Mapfre Company)
- 13 - 16 years old

WINNERS

Special Prize - \$300 (For the school with best participation)

First Prize - \$300 (\$200 for the student and \$100 for the school)

Second Prize - \$200 (\$100 for the student and \$100 for the school)

Third Prize - \$100 (for the student)
