PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder has acquired general skills relating to:

Handles the various desktop publishing systems and software programs and has a broad knowledge of typography and the fundamentals of graphic design, all of which is supported by basic artistic training. This training cycle is designed to meet the increasing demand for professionals who have expertise in desktop publishing and electronic publishing.

Within this framework, each PROFESSIONAL MODULE includes objectives leading to the following LEARNING RESULTS that the holder acquires.

"Historia del Arte y la Imagen Gráfica" (history of art and graphic image)

The title holder:

- Possesses the necessary knowledge of past and present cultural and artistic cycles.
- Develops his or her intellectual personality and completes their technical and artistic training.
- Knows the essential aspects of the ideological, political, economic, social and aesthetic context in which the graphic arts have been generated throughout History with special reference to desktop publishing.

"Autoedición" (desktop publishing)

The title holder:

- Correctly uses computer material and equipment.
- Uses a computer as an application technique in the creative and productive process and as a communication and management tool.

"Fundamentos del Diseño Gráfico" (fundamentals of graphic design)

The title holder:

- Knows the elements and basic laws that govern graphic design in order to better interpret the instructions of the designer.
- Solves minor design problems when he or she has not received instructions from the designer or these are not clearly specified.
- Develops his or her artistic sensitivity and creativity.

"Formación y Orientación Laboral" (training and career guidance)

The title holder:

- Knows the legal working framework and the rights and obligations that derive from labour

relations.

- Possesses the economic, commercial and social knowledge that makes it possible to

administer and run a small and medium-sized company, or to work as a self-employed

professional.

- Possesses specific knowledge as to the labour market access mechanisms and selection

systems, and the skills that make it easier to find work.

- Knows the institutional bodies, both national and community, that help labour insertion and the

services that provide economic aid and subsidies for entrepreneurial initiatives and self-

employment.

- Knows the legal instruments specific to the speciality.

RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The holder of a Diploma of Education in Plastic Arts and Design in Desktop Publishing carries

out his or her professional activity as an expert in Desktop Publishing in Desktop Publishing

companies, photocomposition workshops, printing houses, etc., in a graphic design studio, in

those companies or public entities which due to their importance and the volume of the work

they handle need their own publishing department (reports, balance sheets, bulletins,

presentations, company magazines, annual reports, etc.), in the publishing world: daily

newspapers, magazines, books. He or she may also work as a freelancer with capacity to solve

basic graphic design problems.

OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the body awarding the certificate: The Ministerio de Educación, Cultura

y Deporte (the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport) or the Autonomous Communities in the

area of their own administrative responsibility. The degree has academic and professional

effects that are valid throughout the entire State.

Official duration of the Diploma: 950 hours.

Level of the certificate (national or international).

NATIONAL: Post-compulsory secondary education.

INTERNATIONAL:

- Level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED3).

Minimum teaching requirements established by the State: Royal Decree 1457/1995, of 1
September, which establishes the diplomas of Education in Plastic Arts and Design in
Final Artwork for Graphic Design and in Desktop Publishing, which belong to the
professional family of Graphic Design, and approves the corresponding minimum
education requirements.
